How much electricity does Ukraine produce?

Before 2022, Ukraine produced roughly 44 GW of available electricity, over half of which came from nuclear sources. Coal was the source of around 23% of the country's generation, followed by natural gas (9%), hydroelectric (6.5%), solar (4%), and wind (2%).

How important is Ukraine's energy sector?

Ukraine's air defences provided some protection, but the scale of the attack and the resulting disruption highlighted once again the vital strategic importance of Ukraine's energy sector, as well as the ever-present risks to the country's energy supply.

Is Ukraine making a 'strategic shift' toward Distributed Energy Resources?

Ukraine is making a "strategic shift" toward distributed energy resources. In the two and a half years since Russia invaded Ukraine, Ukraine's energy system has been a regular target, with attacks on thermal and hydro assets, substations, and solar units.

Does Ukraine have a nuclear power plant?

Ukraine operates three nuclear power plants, which produce more than 50% of all electricity, but the plants are forced to reduce production due to damage to power lines. Power cuts also affect heat and water supplies. Residents of Kyiv and the Kyiv region have been getting electricity for only about 10 hours out of 24 over the past week.

The deficit has been managed by Ukraine's state-owned electricity transmission system operator, Ukrenergo, through rolling cuts to supply, limiting electricity provision in the worst-affected regions to ...

Disruptions to Ukraine's power grid have led to outages there and in neighboring Moldova. Kyiv's metro and water supply have both been affected.

There was a shortage of electricity in Kiev due to the shutdown of two thermal power plants, said Deputy of the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine Alexei Kucherenko on October 15.

"The situation in Kyiv remains one of the most difficult - currently, up to 50% of consumers in the capital are without electricity," Ukraine's energy ministry said on Telegram.
