Did Russian military deactivate Starlink Internet terminals in Ukraine?

REUTERS/Lisi Niesner/File Photo KYIV, Feb 5 (Reuters) - Starlink internet terminals used by the Russian military on the battlefield in Ukraine have been deactivated, Ukraine said on Thursday, in what one official described as a "disaster" for Moscow that had disrupted its assault operations in many areas.
