The H K Porter Company was the leading manufacturer of light duty steam locomotives for nearly a century beginning in the late 1860s. It ceased production in 1950.

When was the last Porter locomotive built?

The last locomotive was built in 1950, but the company continues to produce industrial equipment to this day. Porter was known for building locomotives that were much smaller than those normally used by the larger Class I railroads. The company's locomotives were small enough that they were often operated by only one person.
