The LESE regulations set out the minimum requirements for long-term production projects under which a private party owns a power plant whose electricity is sold exclusively to the CFE.

Under this new structure, CFE is mandated to perform transmission, distribution, marketing and basic supply of electricity activities directly. For other activities, CFE may operate ...

There is only one distribution system operator, "CFE Distribución" is responsible for distribution and marketing of electric power and rural electrification.
